Course contents and costs & career options

Welcome to the horseridingcoach.com unique instructor training system

You can now choose the right course that provides you with a qualification, the knowledge and the confidence to fulfil your dreams and achieve your goals.

Our system is flexible and allows you to study either online or via correspondence wherever you are or when you have time. We provide the information in study units. Each course requires certain study units. There is the easy option to continue your development as a coach by adding further units.

Which course is right for you?

Feel free to contact us to discuss which course would be most suitable for you before you enrol. Each course has its advantages.

Certificate III in Sport Coaching Equestrian (SIS30710) - Units 001 - 012

This course is the first step in Equestrian Coaching. It is suitable if you want to begin your coaching career, either working in a riding centre, working for yourself, setting up a small equestrian business. It makes it possible for you to help other people get started with horses as a recognised, qualified instructor, who is able to gain insurance.



It covers horse care on a larger scale than just one or two horses, risk management and safety, how to create a safe place or activity for the general public. Then it deals with the principles of coaching, how people learn and lesson planning, basic riding skills, teaching the beginner and some event organisation. Add basic business skills unit, to help you move on from just a hobby to generating an income.

If you are in a hurry to start teaching obviously this is the quickest path to becoming qualified.

As some of the sections of this course are repeated in the Certificate IV it is possible to continue your studies to a higher level after completing the Certificate III by just adding units at a nominal cost once you are already teaching and making an income.

Certificate IV in Sport Coaching Equestrian (SIS40510) - Units 004 - 016

If you are a little more mature and have had horses for many years or have been teaching already, you can start at the Certificate IV level. This course assumes you have a certain amount of knowledge of horse care and horse psychology. Some essential sections of the Certificate III are included, but it contains more detailed teaching at a higher level and therefore usually takes slightly longer to complete.

Certificate III in Outdoor Recreation Trail riding and Arena teaching (SIS30410) - Units 001 - 008, 010, 012 & 017)

Now we also offer a full qualification if you want to work in or run a trail riding operation. It includes getting people started in an enclosed area, before taking them out on trail, as well as the required horse care and management, how to deal with the public and how to run a safe operation.

Teach riders with disabilities units (RDA) Unit 018 Available end Sept. 2011

After you have completed any of the above courses and wish to include teaching people with disabilities, you can add these units and qualify in this field. The insurance companies will insure you and your helpers in these programs, provided all is documented correctly.

Business skills for equestrian operators - Unit 019 Available from Oct. 2011

When you set up an equestrian business you need to be aware of the "bottom line". If this is more than a hobby to you, it is essential to have basic business skills, and how to manage financially. Add this unit to become truly professional.



Recognition

Horseridingcoach.com has been an approved Registered Training Organisation (RTO no 5455) and delivered this instructor training system since 1998.

Our courses are approved through the **Department of Education and Training** in all Australian States and Territories as **Vocational Education** and are listed on the National Training Information Service (NTIS), web: www.training.gov.au. This means that there is easy **credit transfer** with other qualifications. If you have completed another horse related approved course which has the same units of competency, this can be transferred to our course.

It also means that the course is suitable as part of the curriculum for **school based training** while you are at **high school**, and it can count towards your Certificate of Education or you can leave school with an approved Vocational qualification.

In Queensland horseridingcoach.com is an approved preferred provider for User Choice, and students who are in a (school based or other) traineeship can have the course cost paid for them by the Department of Education.

The courses are approved by **Centrelink** for study related payments for eligible students. Student must be registered and have paid the \$100 enrolment fee to be able to obtain a Confirmation of Enrolment letter which they take to Centrelink.

Employers can access funding by employing staff listed with **employment agencies** and enrolling them in our approved courses.

Insurance

Although we are not the insurer ourselves, we have made arrangements on behalf of our students and graduates with a **choice of insurers**, who are aware of the standard of training we provide. They have agreed to insure our students once they have completed the theory component of the course, to enable them to be covered while finalising the practical requirements.

There are no membership requirements for instructors or their clients. Provided you apply the general risk minimisation principles, there are no restrictions on who you teach.

How do the courses work?

To start any of the courses you must be a registered student. You can register and enrol on our website www.horseridingcoach.com.

The course competencies are delivered in clusters called study units (001-019). You can either buy the units from our website in single units as you go along, or in blocks, or as a whole. In the last 2 cases you receive a discount.

Theory

You have the choice to study the **online version**, which means that you get access to the texts, download, print and collate your own texts and do the theory assessment online. Alternatively you choose the online with **printed version**, which means we send you the printed texts in folders. In that case you can either do the assessments via correspondence, or do them online, which is often much quicker, and allows you to fully set your own pace.

At the end of each section of texts are **Assessment questions**. Some are multiple choice, true/false questions and others require a short answer or assignment. Online work is automatically assessed, apart from the short answers which are assessed by your **tutor**.

Our Learning Management System records your progress automatically so you and we can follow

your progress closely. It is quick and fun to do your study in this interactive way. If ever you are stuck with a question, just call the horseridingcoach.com office and we will explain and help you on your way. You are fully in charge of the speed with which you do the course.

Some units have theory only, others require both theory and **practical assessments**. These units also include **support DVDs**.

Practical

The practical assessment can be done with an **approved qualified assessor**. The cost of the practical assessment is additional to the theory and is paid directly to the assessor. It varies depending on the experience level of the student as some are assessed as competent straight away, and others may require some more work or help.



You can do a **search for an assessor** in your local area from our home page. If you do not have an assessor close by, you can also do your assessments via **video**, and send the videos to our office to be assessed at a nominal fee. You can use a combination of face to face or video assessment, whatever works best for you. We are that flexible!

You can also nominate an assessor who is not listed provided he or she meets the **requirements**, set by the Department of Education. Nominees must:

- Have skills specific coaching qualifications of the same or higher level
- Have Training and Assessor qualifications TAA40104 or TAE40110 or equivalent
- Have a minimum of 5 years industry experience
- Be registered, inducted and have signed an agreement with horseridingcoach.com
- Have access to training materials/Assessment Guides
- Have fulfilled legal requirements (including public liability insurance)
- Communicate with horseridingcoach.com on a regular basis regarding the student's progress.

What is included in the payment?

As you work through the course you receive:

- **Extensive Course notes** (either online or in print as well) with texts, pictures, explanations and advice. (More or less a blue print for running an equestrian business). Complete lesson plans for all teaching tasks that explain the "how to", things that go wrong and how to correct them
- **Support DVDs**, visually demonstrating all the practical aspects
- **Theory** assessment and feedback
- **Access to a tutor** via a "ticket online", or support on request direct from horseridingcoach.com via telephone or email
- **Assessment Guide**, listing the practical tasks required
- **Teaching Logbook**, in which you record your teaching practice
- **A Learning Management System** that records your progress and achievements so you can check on line where you are at.

As the course materials are constantly updated and upgraded, students will automatically have access to the latest versions online. However a flat administration fee of \$100 will be charged every 2 years to cover cost of transfer to new versions and of records to upgraded systems or courses.

When can you start?

Anyone with an interest in horses, riding and coaching can enrol in the course. There are no age restrictions. There are no set start dates, so you can start right now, just register and enrol on our website www.horseridingcoach.com.

Each course lists the units required, and as the information and training is progressive, you need to follow the sequence in which the units are listed. **A \$100 enrolment fee** will be added to your first order.



If you want to apply for Centrelink support or for Recognised Prior Learning (if you have any previous qualifications) you must have paid this enrolment fee. Please contact our office on 07 3209 1648 or email if you want to just pay this fee only.



What do you need?

All students need access to a **computer** and their own personal **email address**. Most of our communication is through Newsletters and electronic means.

You need to be able to read, understand and discuss easy to read printed matter in English and write simple statements, recognise numbers and perform basic numerical calculations. There is no formal selection process.

Ideally you are an **effective rider** before you start the course. However, there is the opportunity during the course to improve on your riding if necessary, but you will need to allow time for this to happen.

For the practical components you need to have access to safe **riding facilities, horses, basic equipment and riders**. The horse or facilities do not have to be your own, but can be through a riding school, pony club, or privately owned. The riders can be genuine riding school students, or friends and relatives.

How much does it cost?

The costs of the various courses are listed in the attached schedules. You can buy per unit or block in blocks, which gives you a **5% discount**. Buying the entire course also saves on postage etc.

The online version of the course is the cheapest, for print orders we add printing, postage and handling costs.

You order your units from our website through your student area after you have enrolled. Payment via credit card or pay-pal gives you immediate access to the texts. Orders paid for by direct deposit, cheque or money-order are processed as soon as the payment is cleared. Our website is secured, so you do not have to worry about buying online.

How long will it take?

The course is self paced, so **you are in charge of your own progress**. Some people have completed the Certificate III in three months, on top of work and family commitments, because they needed it for a job. Others take a lot longer. It is up to you. After 2 years we charge a \$100 administration fee to cover enrolment upgrades and transfer of achievements.

Senior First Aid Certificate (Apply First Aid)

This is a requirement for the course which we have outsourced to the experts in this field. You can do this training with the training organisation of your choice (St John, TAFE's or private providers) and send us a copy of the certificate so we can mark it off before we award you with your qualification.

Study related payments through Centrelink and other Government organisations

Our courses are approved through Centrelink. If you are eligible to access **funding or support** click the Centrelink box on your registration. Once your enrolment payment has been received we can supply you with a Confirmation of Enrolment letter which you then take to Centrelink. Depending on the course you chose, you can get up to 2 years of support for full time study. This means that you get a Study Schedule and have to complete units according to a time table. Enquire with Centrelink what your options are.

There are also various **employment related schemes** for people wanting to join the workforce, be-

come qualified and start making an income. In these cases either the course is paid in full or in part, or the employer is paid incentives to employ and provide training. Even if you want to become self employed you can benefit from these schemes in areas where the industry is not yet developed.

School based training

The Certificate III courses are suitable for people who want to do Vocational Education as part of their Certificate of Education while still at school.

You can either do the full qualification or part of it, and the points will contribute to your overall point score.

Take this brochure to your **VET coordinator or Careers officer** at your school. We are also happy to talk to them, and explain your options.

Recognition of Prior Learning

If you have formal qualifications or Statements of Attainments through AQF (Australian Qualifications Framework) you can supply these and can be given credit if they are relevant and reasonably current. You can register as a student, pay your \$100 enrolment fee, send us your documents, and we will then let you know with which section of the course to start.

If you have a lot of experience, we will ask you to complete the theory component of the course to ascertain that all students work from the same information base. For a number of practical tasks you can document your experience through Statutory Declarations and references, which can be marked off. However other tasks must still be demonstrated as it is our responsibility to produce safe instructors, who are in turn responsible for their student's safety and well being and must make sure the highest standards are met. Of course experienced students can do the practical work in blocks and be assessed in a far shorter time frame than students who are starting out.

Opportunities for overseas students:

If you don't live in Australia these courses can be very suitable for you. We have produced quite a few international graduates to date. You study the course online, and provide video footage of your practical work. Occasionally there are overseas locations with approved assessors, but the majority of international students work through electronic means and it works!

Legal requirements

From May 1, 2002 students over 18, where applicable, may be required by law to obtain a 'Working with Children Check' Suitability card before starting the practical component of the course when training in a situation dealing with young children. This check is free of charge for people working in a voluntary capacity.

Refund Policy

Students pay for sections of the course as they go, so no advance course fees are held by horseridingcoach.com. However, horseridingcoach.com has a refund policy in place. Students who are unable to continue the course can apply to horseridingcoach.com within a two week period from the purchasing date. A refund will be given minus a charge for administration expenses, provided course materials are returned in good order.

Records

horseridingcoach.com is responsible for student's records. Records of all student's competencies are kept by horseridingcoach.com administration. In the first instance they should approach horseridingcoach.com within 30 days of receiving the training or result of the assessment or disciplinary action in writing.

horseridingcoach.com will review the decision with the student and or assessor, clarifying why decisions were made and identifying the student's reasons for grievance in writing.

If the student still feels there are grounds for dispute, horseridingcoach.com will forward the evidence to an independent panel consisting of highly regarded coaches and assessors for their consideration and decision. The student has the opportunity to formally present his or her case either in writing or in person. The written statement of the appeal outcomes including the reasons for the decision will forwarded to the student within 30 days.
